## Your Excellency Shri. Narendra Modi ji,

As India host the second informal summit between Your counterpart - Chinese President Xi Jinping and Your kindself at Mamallapuram near Chennai from 11th to 12th October 2019 to discuss upon overarching issues of bilateral, regional and global importance, the Core Group for Tibetan Cause — India, being the Apex body of all the Indian Tibet Support Groups in India, express our good wishes for the successful turnout of this summit.

We are fully aspirant that Your Leadership has not only brought a transformation of the plight of Indian community but created a new dimension from India to Bharat. Having stated this, while initiating the dialogue with Your counterpart, may we also bring to Your kind attention upon the following points that;-

- 1. The unresolved question of Tibet is a matter of great concern not only to the Tibetans in their homeland and in exile, but also to India and rest of the Humanity. Unfortunate self-immolation by over 153 Tibetans inside Tibet since 2009 is a clear indication of the gravity of human rights situation in Tibet under Chinese rule. In view of this, the Chinese Government must take tangible steps to improve the human rights situation inside Tibet and immediately stop the religious and cultural repression in Tibet.
- 2. The dialogue between representatives of His Holiness the Dalai Lama and the People's Republic of China which has been suspended since 2010 and it is our earnest request that the dialogue be resumed as soon as possible without further delay.
- 3. We would like to request to build pressure upon the Chinese authorities to stop disturbing the fragile ecology of the Tibetan plateau by bringing together all the riparian states affected by such activities.
