SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

Tuition fees will be reimbursed as per bill with a maximum ceiling of Rs.2 Lakh. Other than that, expenses like capitation fees/donations will not be reimbursed. An additional maintenance allowance of Rs.75,000 will be provided per year. For continuation of the TPSP scholarship, one must score 60 % in Academic results.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1.Applicant must be a Tibetan refugee student who has a Green Book (GB). Applicant and his/her parents' Green Book contribution must be paid till 2023. Information about GB must be mentioned in "Form-A" and attested by the concerned Tibetan Settlement Officer.
- 2.Applicant must have scored at least 65% in Bachelor's degree. Preference will be given to fresh graduates. (Upload Bachelor's Mark Sheets)
- 3.Two reference letters from a former teacher, professor, employer, professional colleague, or mentor.
- 4.Personal statement no longer than 1,000 words.
5. Curriculum vitae no longer than two page in length.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1.Eligible candidates will be called for an interview.
- 2.In the event of a tie, preference will be given to the candidate with the higher undergraduate score.
